- SCGI and ASTUS are two industrial companies located near Le Creusot (Saône-et-Loire), specializing in the manufacturing of fabricated, welded and machined metal parts.
- The Group (SCGI + ASTUS) produces custom medium- to heavy-duty metal components, in small and medium production runs, primarily for the nuclear sector. Its clients notably include Framatome, Westinghouse, Arabelle Solutions, and Naval Group.
- The Group stands out in particular for its ability to industrialize specific components (e.g., turbine blades for General Electric produced in batches of 300 to 400 units).
- Its operations are structured around three complementary and synergistic business units:
 - Stainless steel fabrication (SCGI): industrial metal fabrication, welding, and finishing of metal parts;
 - 3D laser cutting and welding (SCGI): cutting and welding of metal parts up to 15 meters in length;
 - Machining (ASTUS): milling and turning of all types of metals.
- The Group employs 17 FTEs across two production sites.
- System Électronique is an independent French company, founded in 1990 and headquartered in Montchanin (Saône-et-Loire). It positions itself as a committed player dedicated to industrial excellence, delivering reliable and sustainable technical solutions to ensure the performance of equipment in the most demanding industries.
- Its expertise notably includes electronic and electromechanical maintenance, obsolescence management, Maintenance in Operational Condition (MCO), and the engineering of tailor-made solutions.
